Reflection

God's revelation to men and women is a revelation of all truth. It is quite wrong to think of it as confined to what we might call theological truth. The theologians and the preachers are not the only people who are inspired. When a poet delivers a great message in words which defy time,

that is inspiration. When H. F. Lyte wrote the words of 'Abide with me', he had no feeling of composing them; he wrote them as to dictation. A great musician is inspired. Handel, telling of how he wrote the Hallelujah chorus, said: 'I saw the heavens opened.' When a scientist discovers something which will help the world's toil and make life better for everyone, when a surgeon discovers a new technique which will save lives and ease pain, when someone discovers a new treatment which will bring life and hope to suffering humanity, that is a revelation from God. All truth is God's truth, and the revelation of all truth is the work of the Holy Spirit.
